Board of Directors Meeting
Minutes April 30, 2026**

Call to Order: 6:00 by President GK, a quorum being present

Approval of Minutes March 23, 2026 M/GD to approve S/VV Carried

Office Manager's Report (VD): no report

Oven update- GK reports the problem was identified and fixed by the Gas Company service person who fixed an issue of wired touching behind the control panel on the lower oven. Additionally, he reports that something is stuck in the convection fan in the upper oven which makes an intermittent metallic crackling sound but is not impacting the function. VD has been assigned to contact the gas company commercial appliance specialist who will come out at no charge.

President's Report: Gary Katayama

Cancellation notices to contracted renters- due to issue with just a few days' notice when the contract for the added full rent event that had been initiated some time earlier. There is a 30 cancellation clause in the long term rental contracts which she has been reminded to honor

New stage curtains- The new side panels have been installed with screws & washers so they can be easily taken down when needed and avoid damage to the fabric. They are meant to be on rods which will be a future project. GK introduces the idea of painting the back wall of the stage area black to function as blackout curtains. Issue referred to the Facilities Committee

Review of Financials: Keith Swanson, Financial Committee Chair

March 2026 - KS suggests more description on certain line items and consolidation of some categories on the reports. GK points out that they are Quick Books designations. Finance Committee to review. KS recommends that the Charter bundle for internet and phone be reviewed for potential savings and/or costing out services from other vendors. Clarifies that the

“furnishings” entry of \$3500 was for the stage curtain side panels, which GK confirms. A loss of \$171 was incurred last month with Fiscal YTD standing at a loss of \$2700

Member Organization Reports:

- People Helping People: Rep. Richard Margetson- reports that the extra rummage sale mentioned a few months ago will be held 6/5-6/6 if the dates are available. RM also informs the Board that PHP is assuming the rental cost of the SBCC for Meals That Connect until the finances of that program improve, in order to keep the program in Los Osos
- Rotary Club of Los Osos: Rep, Dick Pacoan- will be cleaning the exterior windows on May 9th at 9 a.m. all welcome to join, just bring a squeegee, all other supplies will be provided.
- LOBP Chamber of Commerce: Rep. Gary Dove the chamber is having to relocate the Beer Garden due to construction of a new building at the location used for the last number of years. Other former locations have new landscaping and/or new ownership. This is a big revenue generator for the Chamber, so work continues
- Kiwanis of Bay Osos: Rep. Cherrie Katayama- BBQs upcoming at Baywood elementary and the Morro Bay fire Department with proceed for that one to go to the Kiwanis scholarship fund for MBHS students

PHP and SBCC Executive Board agreement on financial turnover- GK requests meeting of the two Boards on turnover plans in order to present a joint plan to the Board of Supervisors. GK to send draft document of issues to RM

Meeting with county Counsel-RM reports the meeting is now to be with the County Real Property Division of the Parks & Rec Department. Need a letter of introduction from PHP first Attorney Retainer for dissolution of 401c3- GK Not to that point yet

- **Facilities:** Chair: GK Members: BC, GD

Parking lot drainage issue with County-RM insists that it has never been asked of the SBCC before, GK points out the clause in the lease being cited by the County. GK to send an email to Callie Beard for clarification.

Parking lot lighting-GK thinks it's been fixed, but longer daylight hours may mean it hasn't been an issue

Postcard mailing- update. New drafts for review discussed. DP points out that full color increases costs. Sending to the entire 93402 Zip Code costs \$3339. Discussion about focusing in on the zones with businesses as that has been more successful, also eliminate those with few addresses.

M/GD S/JD to get quote for color cost to add business sections with a cap of \$4000. Carried
